School-Based Mental Health Services (SBMH)

School-Based Mental Health (SBMH) is a collaborative program between partnered school districts and Clarvida providing outpatient mental health services in the school setting. Students with identified needs for supports would be afforded the opportunity during the school day to attend therapy sessions.

Intensive Behavioral Health Services (IBHS)

Focuses on skill development to support emotional and behavioral issues for children ages 2 to 21 years of age through a child-centered, strengths-based approach. Services are provided in the home, school, and community settings as deemed necessary by the child's treatment team.

Behavioral Consultation and Intervention Services (BCIS)

A tailored consultation service that may support students, classrooms, school districts, providers, individuals, and families based on presenting needs. Consultation can occur across all settings to support skill maintenance and generalization.

Autism Services

Comprehensive behavior support and training for individuals with autism and their families, provided at home or in schools by trained behavioral health specialists, supervisors, and certified professionals.
